

Job Description – Class A Painter

1.0 Purpose:

Job Descriptions are part of Company Quality Policies and Procedures.

This standard defines the tasks and responsibilities for the Class A Painter. The standard is valid for all Class A Painters.

2.0 General:

Responsible for painting fabricated structures and equipment.

3.0 Tasks and Responsibilities:

The Class A Painter shall be responsible for, but not limited to, the following:

- Apply industrial coatings per recommended thickness.
- Mix, thin and adjust spray equipment for proper atomization.
- Check prime job and apply second coat to specified thickness.
- Productivity level must consistently equal the Company's established productivity requirements, as defined by work instructions.
- Workmanship must meet the Company's quality standards.

4.0 Education and Experience Required:

- High School Diploma / GED
- Two years industrial paint experience.

5.0 Skills Required:

- Paint with minimal supervision.
- Familiar with various coatings.
- Knowledge of fast and slow evaporating solvents.
- Familiar with effects temperature and humidity have on coatings.
- Use dry film thickness gauge, wet mil gauge, and holiday detector equipment.
